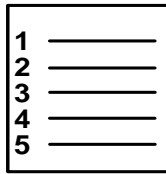
**This is the news from the Partnership Board meeting on
Thursday March 26th 2009**



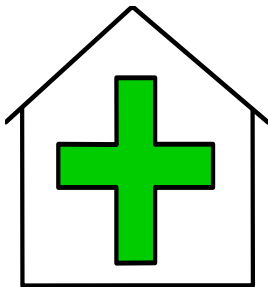
Our meeting was held at Revive Healthy Living

Judi Thorley gave a presentation on Improving People's Health in the East Midlands.

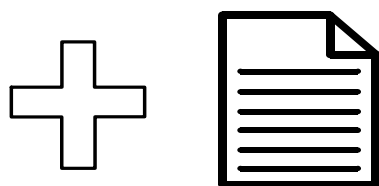
The main issue she talked about was 'Big Health Day'.

It was agreed that forming a sub group would be a good step forward to discuss these issues more fully

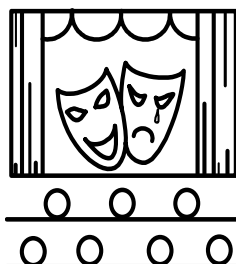

Were very good.

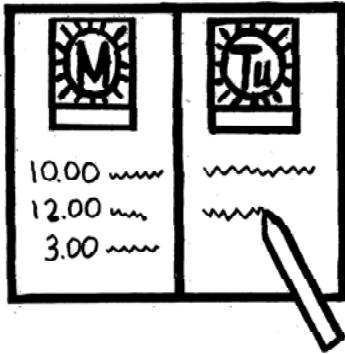
- I can do drama and dance

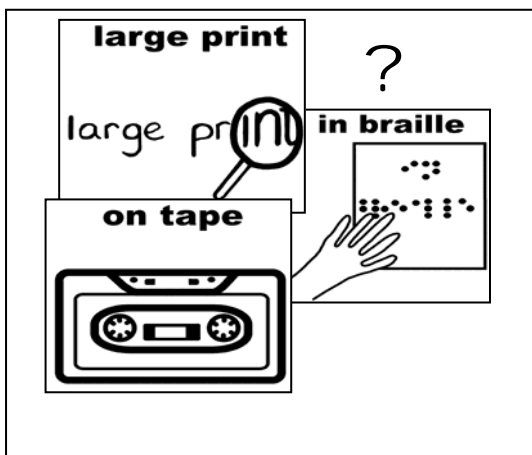

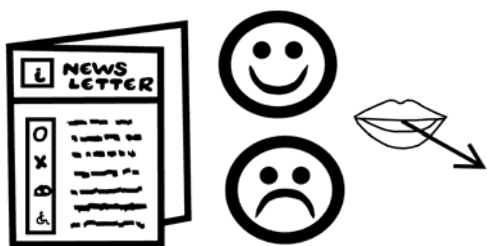
